We will continue to implement "staggered" finish times, and we would still like children to come in and leave school at set doors. Parents won't be allowed on the playground in the morning. When collecting, please wait until your child's year group is called before you come onto the school site.

Face Masks/Social Distancing

From Monday 19th July, the wearing off face masks and social distancing measures are no longer a legal requirement, however the government is still recommending that people continue to show caution in crowded areas such as public transport. We will not be asking parents to wear a face covering when collecting their child/ren from school, but if you would like to continue to do so we will support that.

Safety at Home Time

We need to ensure your children are safe when being dismissed at the end of the day, therefore we would like parents to continue to wait behind the lines or the numbers on the playgrounds and maintain space with other parents. This allows the teacher to see ALL parents and allows the children to easily make their way to their parent. It would be appreciated if you don't shout your child's name or move towards the lines but please wait patiently.

PE/Sports

As we did last year, children will not be expected to change in school for PE lessons or clubs, instead they can come into school in their sports kit on the days they have an indoor PE lesson, an outdoor sports lesson, or an after school sports club.

The correct sports kit comprises of:

- black tracksuit/leggings, white t-shirt, black sweatshirt and trainers.
- Jeans, printed leggings, printed t-shirts are not acceptable.
- Trainers should only be worn on PE or Sports Days.

Current Year 2 Parents

If your child is moving up to Year 3 in September they will no longer be eligible for Universal Free School Meals. So you will need to pay for school meals which is £2.30 per day, £11.50 per week.

Please register for Free School Meals on www.wolverhamptoncitycouncil.gov.uk/freeschoolmeals. Children who qualify for free school meals are also entitled to free milk; a saving to parents of £33.00 per school year.

School Uniform

School uniform can be purchased from Trutex shop in Wolverhampton City Centre (14 Cleveland Street, Wolverhampton, WV1 3HH). Please purchase uniform before the start of term to ensure your child is dressed smartly in full school uniform for the start of school in September. PE kits and school bags are also available.

Arbor Parent Portal

The school's new Arbor parent portal and app is now up and running. To access Arbor you can either login into the Parent Portal through the internet or download the app from your App Store (Google Play or Apple App Store). Through this one app you will be able to receive texts and emails from school, see information on your child's attendance, view the contact details we hold for you and pay for meals, milk and trips. All parents have been sent an email over the last few weeks from Arbor inviting you to create your account. Please ensure you create your account by following the instructions provided. Please remember to check junk and spam folders. If you have any queries, please ring the school office.

The school's previous method of making payments for school dinners, SIMS Pay, has now ceased and you will need to use your Arbor account for all payments in future.
