This could give the make your personal information.

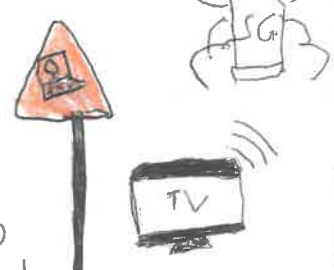
Your big Wi-Fi is better when all those lines are white.

 You have to be 13+ for most of the social media's.
 Why do children use social media, sometimes without you knowing?
 Some children use social media, because of peer pressure. They might feel left out and feel like they have to have social media to "fit in".
 Do you know if your child is using social media?

 Do you know what your child is using their devices for?

Our Top Tips:
 If your child creates an account online, don't use your real name. Also we don't want your child to be a victim of cyberbullying so always teach them how to block.
 Remember, NEVER share personal information online.

Help your child to understand the risks
What they might see or do:
 Online is a dangerous place. your child might find things like inappropriate behaviour, pedophiles and many other disturbing things.
 (Swearing)
Who they might meet:
 Very old pedophiles, stalkers, kidnappers. Watch who your child texts because a simple text can be very serious.
How this could affect them:
 This can make your child really disturbed and very scared. It can also lead to them to start doing what the internet is doing like swearing and starting to be a bad influence towards younger children.
